The Parliamentary Counsel, under the direction of the Chief Parliamentary Counsel and in accordance with Ministerial policies, is responsible and accountable for providing a range of professional drafting services to Ministers, Ministries and Government Departments, and to His/Her Excellency the Governor, to ensure the delivery of Government's Legislative Agenda in a timely and efficient manner; and for providing expert legal advice on the Constitution and laws of Bermuda, and matters of statutory interpretation. In addition, the Parliamentary Counsel participates in the professional development and training programme of the Drafting Section, designed to enhance the legislative drafting skills and professionalism of the Assistant Parliamentary Counsel, Pupils and Law Students, as co-ordinated by the Deputy Chief Parliamentary Counsel. The Parliamentary Counsel undertakes associated legal and operational duties, as requested by the Chief Parliamentary Counsel.

A minimum of five (5) years' relevant post-qualification experience in the drafting of legislation in a Commonwealth jurisdiction is required for the post.

Parliamentary Counsel must have a Law Degree and must be called to the Bar in a Commonwealth jurisdiction. Specialised post-graduate training in legislative drafting is essential.
